



For a place in a municipal school we have to receive your application no later than 15 December.

Choice of school before reception class

The reception class (kindergarten) is the first step into compulsory school. The purpose of the activities is to stimulate every child's continued learning and development. The reception class is compulsory for all children who live in Sweden from the autumn semester of the year that they turn six. The work in the reception class takes place in close contact with the school's other years (grades) and the after-school leisure centre.

The reception class comprises at least 20 hours a week. Each school decides how this time is distributed over the days of the week.

If you have any questions about the activities of the special school for the disabled or want a place for your child in the special school, please contact the head teach of the special school, anette.ekskog@falun.se

During the current pandemic, schools are unable to invite you guardians to information meetings, which otherwise are usually held prior to the choice of school and before beginning in the reception class. Schools will instead have clear information on falun.se in order to describe their activities as much as possible. If you have any thoughts or questions, you are welcome to contact the head teachers and deputy head teachers.

Application

If you want a place in a municipal school, fill in a first, second and third choice on the enclosed form "Choice of school and request for school placement". The form must be received by the Childcare and Education Department of Falun Municipality no later than 15 December at Falu kommun, Barn- och utbildningsförvaltningen, 791 83 Falun. If you applied, but did not receive a place at an independent school unit, and did not apply to a municipal school, you will be given a school placement according to our procedures and priority order for school placement.

Procedure and priority order for handling of school placement in the event of maximum capacity being reached:

1. Pupils who belong to the placement school
2. Pupils who are officially registered in Falun Municipality
3. Other pupils

If there equivalent conditions between pupils, a lottery shall decide.

Notice of school placement

No later than 1 February, you will receive a notice of the school placement by letter to the child's officially registered address.

Application for place at a leisure centre

If you are in need of care before and/or after the school day, there are leisure centres that are subject to a charge. The leisure centres are open from 2 August. You apply for a place at the leisure centre through the municipality's website falun.se once you have received notice of the school placement. There is no queue to the leisure centres.

Application for school transport/bus pass

Children in the reception class are entitled to school transport/a bus pass if the distance between the registered address and placement school is 2 km or more. If you choose a school other than the one you belong to, it is not certain that you have the right to school transport even if the distance from the home is farther.

You apply for school transport/a bus pass through the municipality's website falun.se during the period 22 March – 9 April.
